What is the Healthy Schools Programme?

- Key part of the Government's drive to improve standards of health and education and to tackle health inequalities.
- It aims to make children, teachers, parents and communities more aware of the opportunities that exist in schools for improving health.
- The scheme is sponsored by the Mayor of London (from April 2013) as part of the London Healthy Schools Programme.
- Underpinned by settings' statutory duty to promote the health and wellbeing of their pupils and supports a whole-school approach.




Participating schools are recognised and rewarded for their health promoting activities through an accreditation process with the awarding of Bronze, Silver, and Gold healthy school status.
